



## PROJECT OVERVIEW

### Where we did it:

Khulna, Bagerhat, Satkhira Districts in Bangladesh

### When:

June - December, 2020

### What we did:

We distributed relief immediately to people affected by cyclone Amphan. We constructed houses for those whose houses were destroyed and severely damaged beyond repair by cyclone Amphan.

### Numbers:

Benefited **1,700** people through relief and rehabilitation.

Relief: **400** families, Houses built: **20**




### Accomplishment:

We distributed relief to 400 families which benefited 1600+ individuals and constructed 20 houses for twenty families in Bagerhat, Satkhira and Khulna, Bangladesh.


## PROJECT OVERVIEW

### Why we did it:

A deadly cyclone tore through eastern India and Bangladesh in May, 2020, knocking down trees, smashing countless houses and killing more than 100 people. Striking in the midst of a global pandemic, COVID-19, when people were struggling to bring food on the table. Tropical Cyclone Amphan deepened the misery across some of the vulnerable districts, including Khulna, Bagerhat, Satkhira, Chuadanga, Jessore, Barguna and Noakhali. This damaged thousands of acres of crops, millions of dollars worth of fisheries, poultry and cattle farms, and knocked down thousands of trees.

Thousands of people were desperately looking for food to survive for a few weeks. As many as 500,000 families in Bangladesh became homeless, according to the United Nations Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs.

### Some of the recipients:


**Mr. Yunus Hawlader** is a 60-year-old man who is physically very ill. He has a family of seven with his wife and five children. His family does not have any income due to COVID-19. His house was destroyed in Cyclone Amphan. He lived under the sky with his seven family members. Could you imagine his pain?

**Mrs. Fatema Akhter** is a divorced woman. She lives with her mother who is paralyzed from the illness. She begs to people to lead her family. During Cyclone Amphan, one of the largest trees fell down and hit her hut. The floodwater quickly filled inside the house and destroyed whatever little belongings she had. She and her mom became hopeless. Who could give them hope?

**Mr. Md. Habibur Rahman Khan** works and earns 8000 BDT monthly which is equivalent to \$100 USD. His wife is paralyzed and can't do anything. He has to take care of his nine children. His oldest son used to work to help his family but he lost his job due COVID-19. During cyclone Amphan, four big trees have fallen on the roof of the house and heavy storm flushed away the sides of the house and other belongings in the house. He became very depressed after facing one calamity after another. Who could bring his happiness back?

**Mr. Sahil Uddin** had few acres of land that he used to cultivate to live his life. But he lost his land and house due to river erosion and became destitute. He turned to day laborer job and lived hand to mouth with his family of four people. However, due to COVID-19, he did not have any work. He and his family starved many times unable to manage any food. In this difficult situation, Cyclone Amphan destroyed his hut and washed away his belongings. With his house collapsed and flooded in cyclone Amphan, the world became difficult for him. Could we make a better place for him and his family?


