PROJECT OVERVIEW

Where we did it:

Chapai Nababgonj, Jessore, Cox's Bazar,
Dinajpur and Dhaka, Bangladesh

When:

August, 2020

What we did:

We distributed fresh meat to extremely vulnerable families living in selected locations across Bangladesh, through the provision of Qurbani meat during of Eid al-Adha, Muslim celebration.

Why we did it:

Eid al-Adha is one of biggest celebration for Muslims all around the world. They observe this through completing Hajj, the annual pilgrimage to Mecca and the sacrificial slaughter of animals, known as Qurbani, to honor the willingness of Prophet Ibrahim (PBUH) to sacrifice his son, Ismail (PBUH). Projects for Humanity is committed to making the Islamic duty of Qurbani accessible and beneficial for everyone involved.

Performing Qurbani in Bangladesh is impactful because 14 percent of population do not have next meal to eat due poverty and COVID-19 making the situation worse. 15.1% of its population does not have enough to meet their minimum daily diets.

Many recipients informed us that they have not had any meat the whole year, which breaks our heart. Many people struggle to provide necessities such as food for their families, how can they celebrate Eid? Therefore, we provided fresh meat so they can get nutrition and enjoy their Eid al-Adha with their family without worrying about how they will pay for it.

Numbers:

38 Qurbanis, 1,500+ Individuals

Accomplishment:

We performed 38 Qurbanis on behalf of our Muslim supporters with proper rituals and safety regulations. We distributed fresh meat which addresses the food needs of 1,500+ individuals in different locations across Bangladesh.
