PROJECT OVERVIEW

Where we did it:

Throughout Bangladesh

When:

January to December, 2020

What we did:

We have collected the application of students who are underprivileged and meritorious. All of the students are in 6th to 8th grade from Bangladesh and have the excellent results at their fifth grade exam. After the rigorous scrutiny of the applications, we selected 58 students among many who met the scholarship eligibility criteria.

We provided 5,000 BDT to each of the 58 to cover the educational expenses for the year of 2020.

Why we did it:

The main objective of this project is to support the talented but underprivileged students who are not able to bear their educational expenses. There are so many students who are talented but poor. Unfortunately, many of them are orphans or their fathers are physically disabled or their families struggle to provide three meals a day. Therefore, there is a huge chance of the students dropping out of school at the very early stages and starting work to support their families. According to BBC, 49% girls and 37% boys are dropping out from high school (6th – 10th grade) due to poverty. Moreover, COVID-19 surge throughout the country made the situation worse, as people were losing their jobs and other sources of income.

Projects for Humanity has taken this wonderful project to support these students. Our goal is that no students will drop out from school and get involved in child labor due to their financial difficulties and flourish according to their potentials.


Total 58 Students

HEART TOUCHING STORIES

Ripon Ali is a student in the seventh grade. His father works in a welding shop as a day labor. He has two brothers and one sister. They don't have any property other than the house. As a son of a poor family, Ripon always struggles to fulfill his basic needs. However, he is a very talented student since he got the Golden A Plus (GPA 5.00) with talent pool scholarship in PSC'2019.

Ripon's dream is to become a doctor in the future by studying hard and to stand beside the poor and helpless people like him. Many will be surprised to hear that this little boy Ripon runs small seasonal business in many times to continue his own studies. For example, he sells eggs, potatoes, and cucumbers to earn some money for bearing his educational expenses. But, when there is no business like this, he struggles to buy school supplies or even to get a meal.

"One day, I (local volunteer) met with him coincidentally. I see Ripon wearing a lungi and taking two bags of potatoes and riding a bicycle. Ripon felt a bit ashamed of seeing me and said salam to me. I replied his salam and said what's up Ripon, what are you taking? Ripon replied, "Sir, I came to the village to buy some potatoes. Sir, sometimes I do a business." After hearing this, I can easily understand, how much struggle Ripon faces everyday due to his poverty. He is fighting for his study from the early age. Instantly, I think that, if we properly nourish Ripon, he will do good in the future. I believe he is our future.

Tamim Ikbal, a son of an office assistant of a primary school of Dinajpur. He is a student of class eight and lives with his parents and a younger brother. With the very little salary of his father, they struggle to meet the basic requirements of the daily life. However, Tamim is a very meritorious student as he got Golden A plus (GPA 5.00) and received the scholarship in the talent pool grade. Tamim and his family has a dream that their son will become a doctor one day and will serve the poor people and the community.

Very recently, Tamim's mother was attacked by brain stroke. Though she survives, she is seriously ill now with the symptoms of paralysis. They have spent a lot of money for her treatment. His father did not have any savings. Therefore, he was compelled to sell some of their land.

Tamim is suffering as he is not getting enough money to bear his educational expenses. His family is spending most of their earning for his mother's treatment. His parents are really worried about Tamim's education. They don't want to stop his education, but they don't have any other option. They want to see their son as a doctor and taking care of the family in the future. Projects for Humanity stands beside Tamim and took the responsibility of his education. P4H also wishes to see him as a successful doctor one day. All the recipients have different heart touching stories like Ripon and Tamim.
