The health and well-being of the orphans are prioritized through regular medical check-ups, vaccinations, and access to healthcare facilities. Cultural activities and training programs further enrich their lives by nurturing their talents, boosting their self-confidence, and preparing them for future success. We remain dedicated to creating a nurturing and empowering environment where orphaned children can thrive and fulfill their potential.

And through the Orphan Scholarship Program, we want to ensure that no matter where he is in Bangladesh, his studies or dreams are not hindered by the financial crisis.





Why We Did

In Bangladesh, there are approximately 4 million orphaned children who face a life of vulnerability and neglect. Among them, many exhibit great talent and untapped potential, but unfortunately, due to the lack of proper opportunities and guidance, their abilities remain undeveloped. As a result, many of these children end up going astray and become perceived as burdens on society.

However, on a positive note, Islamic theology strongly promotes and encourages the care and support of orphans. It emphasizes the importance of looking after these vulnerable children and declares rewards for those who undertake this noble responsibility.

The Quran emphasizes the importance of caring for orphans and treating them with dignity. In one verse, Allah (swt) suggests that a person who ignores orphans is not really a believer.

‘Have you seen the one who denies the Recompense [the religion]? For that is the one who drives away the orphan’. Al Ma’un: 1-2

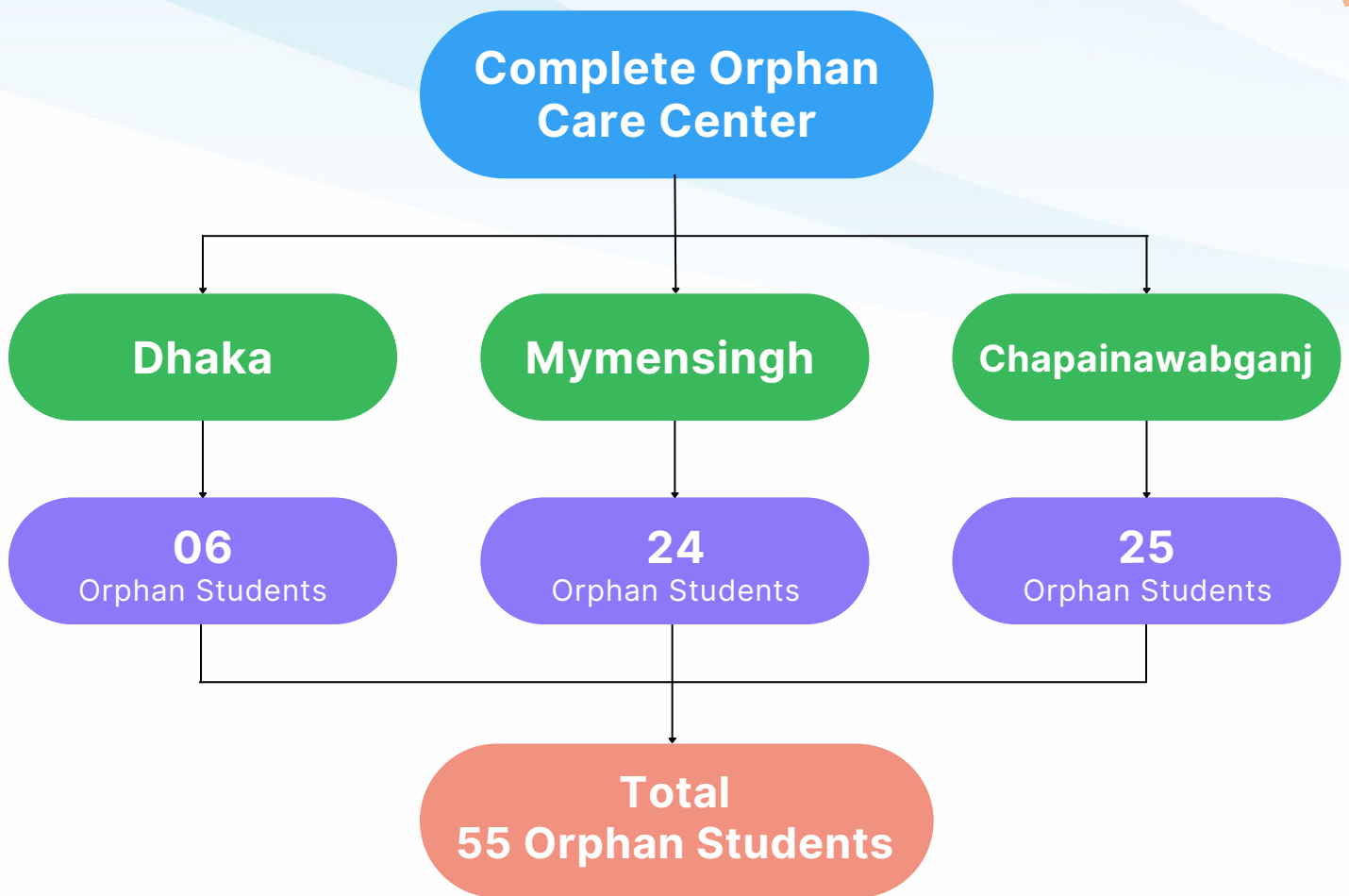
In another, Allah (swt) describes the righteous in Paradise as being those who took care of orphans during their worldly life.

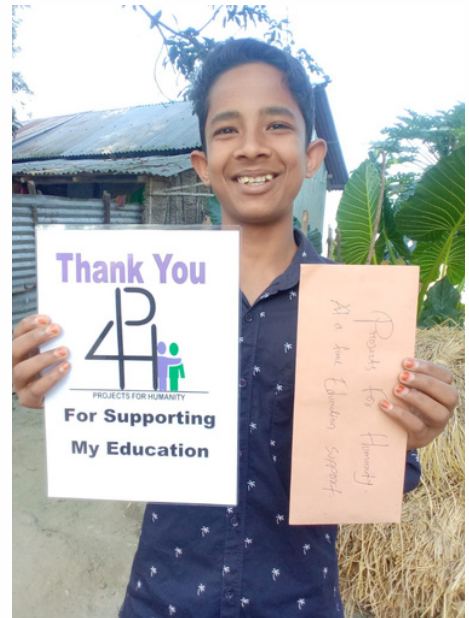




Orphan Scholarship

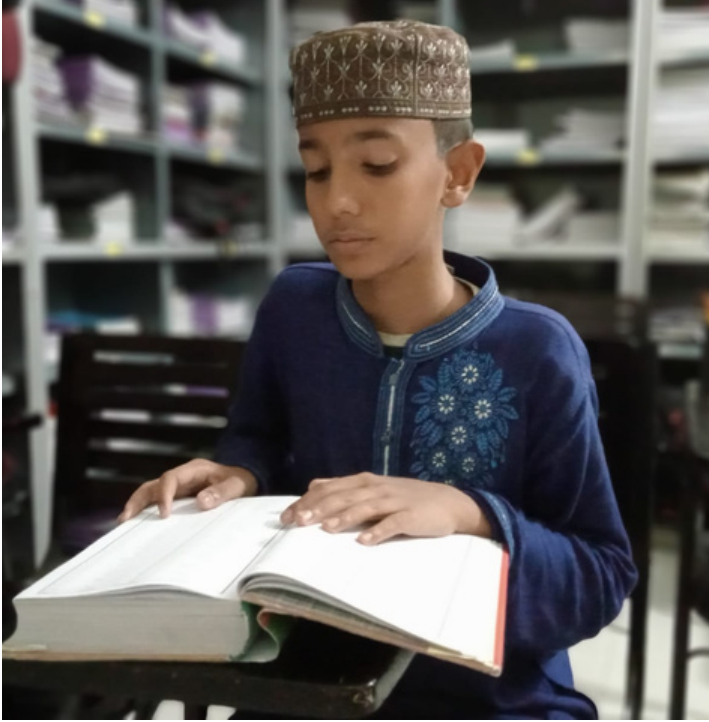

The first blow to this dream came on 3rd April 2020 when Lisan's mother passed away. Lizaan said crying "When I had a mother, she would fulfill all my wishes, if I could do something small, she would make me feel like I had conquered the world; after my mother died, I felt like I had no one left to fulfill my hopes."

The father is not fully able to work, yet he tries to raise the child in any way he can. There were also obstacles, his own uncles kept causing trouble and turmoil in various ways. It is impossible for this child to continue studying with so much trouble at such a young age!

But Lizan got a chance to do this impossible, through Project for Humanity's Complete Orphan Care. After coming here, he started dreaming again and is continuing his studies accordingly.
