Sadly, apart from the street children, a considerable number of children who have parents and shelter are still not getting the opportunity to go to school. The substantial additional private costs of education that the parents have to meet for their children's schooling are discouraging and a burden for underprivileged and low-income people, leading some children into child labor.

We strongly believe that underprivileged talented students, when provided with the right guidance, educational support, and other basic necessities such as nutritious food, have the potential to become invaluable assets to our nation. By empowering these students with the resources they need, we can help them achieve their full potential and foster self-reliance.





Our Service

We offer two types of support to guarantee quality education for underprivileged and economically disadvantaged students, covering their educational journey from the first grade to the university level.

Through our Creative Champions Project (CCP), we create an inclusive and nurturing environment where these young minds can thrive and develop their skills. By offering them access to quality education and mentoring and other basic necessities such as nutritious food, we aim to unlock their hidden talents and abilities. We understand that talent is distributed evenly, but opportunities are not. Therefore, we are committed to bridging this gap and providing equal opportunities to all deserving students.

Additionally, we extend both one-time and recurring scholarships to students hailing from remote regions, ensuring they have the opportunity to thrive and succeed in their academic pursuits. Together, we aim to create a brighter and more promising future for these deserving individuals.

Despite facing challenges from birth due to their natural environment, geography, and social circumstances, these students exhibit remarkable talent and intelligence. Born into extreme poverty, they learn to navigate the world without proper health care, nutritious food, or guidance, making them mature and gifted beyond their years.

Unfortunately, many of them must abandon their studies before reaching high school due to family and financial hardships, and even those with excellent primary-level results struggle to secure admission to reputable educational institutions.

Regrettably, without adequate support and opportunities, many of these children end up engaging in various anti-social and terrorist activities, becoming a burden on society. Addressing the root causes of their vulnerabilities and providing them with the necessary guidance and resources is crucial to break this cycle and create a safer, more harmonious community for everyone.

Our mission is to nurture these promising students, who emerge as 'Champions' despite the odds and transform them into successful citizens. By assuming responsibility for their educational journey beyond the initial phase, we aim to provide them with the support and opportunities they deserve. Through this effort, we envision a brighter future where these talented individuals can overcome obstacles and become valuable contributors to society.



Creating Champions Project (CCP)

In our Creating Champions Project (CCP), we meticulously select talented and underprivileged students from all over Bangladesh. As part of this initiative, we not only offer them exceptional education but also provide accommodation and food facilities. Our support extends beyond formal school-based learning, as we arrange home quizzes, in-house sports competitions, self-development training, and other activities to foster their talent and growth.

To ensure their well-being, we fulfill their basic needs by offering medical care, clothing, and education, aiming to shape them into well-rounded individuals and exemplary human beings. Through CCP, we cultivate an environment where these young minds can thrive, irrespective of their socio-economic background, empowering them to realize their fullest potential.





Education Scholership

Numerous disadvantaged students face the unfortunate reality of dropping out before reaching high school due to family and financial challenges. Even those with commendable primary-level results find it difficult to secure admission to prestigious institutions due to the lack of financial support.

To address this pressing issue, we have taken concrete steps by establishing the Education Scholarship Program. Through this program, we offer 46 scholarships, including both one-time (36+ scholarships) and recurring (10+ scholarships) opportunities, to deserving and meritorious students.

Through these scholarships, we aim to ensure that they can continue their studies unhindered, transforming into valuable assets for the country and achieving self-reliance. By investing in their education and empowering them with opportunities, we envision a future where these students can thrive and make significant contributions to society.










Talent Hunt Process of CCP


Transforming Lives Impact Story of Repion Ali

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It is tragic that despite a boy having a GPA of 5 in primary grade and receiving a Talent Pool scholarship in 2019. But, he cannot continue his studies due to his family's inability to support his private expenses alongside his educational costs.

Ripon Ali, a 14-year-old young boy, comes from a family of five members with his father working as an informal mason. The irregularity of his father's income made it challenging to cover household expenses and provide education for Ripon and his three siblings. To finance their studies, Ripon and his brother run a seasonal vegetable shop.





Three years ago, by a stroke of coincidence, our local volunteer came across Ripon Ali, clad in a small lungi and carrying two bags of potatoes with a broken bicycle. Ripon seemed a bit embarrassed to see them and saluted. They returned the salutation and asked, "What's up, Ripon? What are you carrying?". Ripon replied, "Sir, I buy potatoes from the village. I do this business occasionally."

After hearing about Ripon's situation, our volunteer was deeply shocked and decided to take action. They arranged all his education expenses through P4H. Subsequently, Ripon became a part of the Creating Champions project, and we took on all the responsibilities to support him in achieving his dreams. He is a humble boy and is currently excelling in his studies.

Similar to Ripon Ali, there are millions of talented but economically disadvantaged students in Bangladesh who are forced to abandon their dreams at a very young age due to a lack of financial support from their families.

In our Creating Champions Project (CCP), we extend a helping hand to underprivileged and talented students like Ripon Ali, empowering them to become champions. Through proactive outreach, we take on the responsibility of providing the necessary support they need to excel and achieve their dreams.
