

Transforming Lives Impact Story of Abdul Aziz

Abdul Aziz was born in a small village Sabuj Para in Kurigram named district. Life was simple but filled with love, until tragedy struck in 2015 when his father passed away due to illness the family couldn't afford to treat. In the years that followed, Aziz endured Abdul hardship, neglect, and displacement - moving from his mother's remarried home to distant relatives who were strangers by blood but kind enough to offer shelter.

Yet through every struggle, one thing remained constant in Abdul's heart: his thirst for knowledge. He dreamed of a life where education could break the chains of poverty and pain.



That dream found its wings when Projects for Humanity (P4H) discovered Abdul Aziz and welcomed him into Champion Academy two years ago. Here, for the first time, Abdul found not just a classroom, but a family. A place where caring teachers, safe shelter, and proper education rebuilt his hopes.

His dedication paid off — in 2024, Abdul Aziz ranked first in his class in the final exam. His story is a powerful reminder of how education transforms lives and how, with the right opportunity, a child from even the hardest beginnings can rise to shine.

Today, Abdul Aziz is determined to continue his journey and one day serve his community — just as P4H and Champion Academy have stood beside him.
