LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT

Dear esteemed friends, donors, volunteers & well-wishers,

Peace Be Upon You All

Projects for Humanity (P4H) was established in September 2017 with the vision of creating meaningful impact through humanitarian initiatives. As a long-time donor to various non-profits, I often wondered how effectively contributions were reaching those most in need. That concern inspired the foundation of P4H—with a promise of the highest level of transparency and accountability. While annual reports are common for organizations, we aim to go further—ensuring that our donors and well-wishers gain a clear understanding of the true impact their support is making in people's lives.

The first half of 2024 brought its share of challenges, with vulnerable communities in Bangladesh continuing to face various hardships. Yet, with your unwavering support, Projects for Humanity (P4H) stood strong—delivering hope, relief, and sustainable solutions.

This half-year, our projects touched thousands of lives:

- ✓ Over 900 Ramadan Food Baskets were distributed, benefiting 6,370 individuals during the holy month.
- ✓ 172 Qurbanis were performed, distributing fresh meat to more than 12,000 individuals across nine districts.
- ✓ 66 orphaned children received holistic care, including education, meals, and medical support, across our three orphan centers.
- 38 free medical camps were organized in five districts, benefiting over 1,700 individuals with essential healthcare services.
- Our two solar-powered RO plants in Shyamnagar, Satkhira, provided 12,000 liters of clean water daily, serving 600 families and 3,000 individuals every day.
- ✓ 125+ families were empowered through livelihood support, including the distribution of 21 sewing machines, 49 livestock, and support for small businesses.
- We supported education for 58 underprivileged students through residential care and 30 students with recurring scholarships across Bangladesh.
- ✓ In refugee assistance, 145 children were served with education tools in Cox's Bazar, 150+ Ramadan food baskets were distributed, and 26 Qurbanis were performed, benefiting over 2,500 people.

What we did

In the first half of 2024, P4H supported the education of vulnerable children through two key initiatives. A total of 58 orphaned and underprivileged children received full residential care at Champion Academy, where they were provided with quality education, nutritious meals, healthcare, and a safe environment to grow and thrive. At the same time, 30 poor and orphan students from three districts were awarded recurring scholarships that covered tuition fees and educational expenses, ensuring they could continue their studies without financial barriers and pursue their dreams with confidence.

Why we did

Across Bangladesh, countless talented children from poor and rural families are forced to give up their education due to financial constraints. Many who could have become future leaders are held back by poverty.

P4H launched Champion Academy and education scholarship programme to break this cycle — offering full support, education, and opportunities to gifted students. We believe that by nurturing their talents, we are shaping future changemakers who will uplift society.

FOOD & NUTRITION

Impact in Ramadan



Multiple Districts in Bangladesh



March- April, 2024

What we did

During Ramadan 2024, P4H reached families with food, Eid essentials, and care. We distributed over 900 Ramadan Food Baskets, provided 300 Suhr and Iftar packages, supported 311 families with Zakat al-Fitr, and delivered 300 Eid Gift packages for children. In total, more than 1,260 families and 6,370 individuals benefited from this project.



For poor families, Ramadan can be a time of hardship as they struggle to afford basic meals for fasting and lack the means to celebrate Eid. By providing food and gifts, we ensured that the sacred month was filled with dignity, nourishment, and joy for the most vulnerable.

FOOD & NUTRITION

Qurbani Meat Distribution



Multiple Districts in Bangladesh

What we did

In Eid al-Adha 2024, P4H successfully performed 172 sacrifices, distributing fresh meat to more than 12,000 people across nine districts. For the most vulnerable, cooked meals were also prepared and delivered, ensuring that even families without the means to cook could partake in the blessings of Eid.

Why we did

Eid al-Adha is one of the most sacred festivals for Muslims, yet countless impoverished families in Bangladesh cannot afford to perform Qurbani due to financial hardship. For many, meat is a rare luxury, and some even lack the basic ingredients to prepare a proper meal. To uphold the spirit of Eid, P4H distributed fresh Qurbani meat to the most vulnerable, ensuring that families who rarely taste meat could celebrate with dignity.

Accomplishment

Iwe distributed both fresh Qurbani meat packages and cooked meals to vulnerable families. Many of them rarely have the chance to eat meat throughout the year. With the generous support of our donors, well-wishers, and dedicated volunteers, we were able to reach and nourish more than 12,000 beneficiaries, ensuring they could celebrate Eid with dignity and joy.

What we did


Through our three orphan care centers, P4H looked after 66 children in the first half of 2024. They were provided with safe shelter, healthy food, medical care, and education—ensuring they grow up with security, dignity, and opportunities for a brighter future.

Why we did

Orphaned children are among the most vulnerable, often deprived of care, protection, and opportunity. P4H established orphan centers to raise them in a safe, nurturing environment where they can grow with dignity.

Accomplishment

66 children were provided with holistic care, growing up healthy, secure, and empowered to build better futures.





REFUGEE ASSISTANCE

Educating Refugee Children & Supporting the Community



Cox's Bazar, Bangladesh



Ongoing Project

What we did

P4H supported 3 schools inside Rohingya camps, reaching 90 children, while another 55 children from host families studied at our Cox's Bazar Elementary Center. During Ramadan and Eid, 150 food baskets and 100 Eid Gift packages were distributed, and 26 Qurbani's Performed provided fresh meat to over 2,000 people.

Why we did

Rohingya refugees continue to live in extreme poverty, facing daily struggles for food, education, and basic necessities. Children in the camps are often deprived of structured learning, while families remain dependent on limited aid for survival. At the same time, host communities carry an additional burden, as their scarce resources are stretched to support the influx of refugees. Recognizing these challenges, P4H extended support not only to refugees but also to vulnerable host families—restoring hope, dignity, and creating opportunities for education, nourishment, and a better future.

Livelihood Support



Multiple districts across Bangladesh



Ongoing Project



In the first half of 2024, P4H empowered families through sustainable livelihood projects. We distributed 21 sewing machines, 49 livestock, 11 rickshaws and vans, and supported 11 small businesses. Additionally, 8 new houses were built, enabling families to live with dignity.



Without stable incomes, families remain trapped in cycles of poverty. By providing resources for sustainable livelihoods, P4H helps families achieve self-reliance and break free from dependency.

Accomplishment

Around 125+ families gained sustainable income sources and safe housing, enabling them to rebuild lives with independence and hope.

Every day, 3000 people gained access to clean drinking water, reducing health risks and the daily struggle of fetching water.







HEALTHCARE

Free Medical Treatment

What we did

In the first half of 2024, P4H organized free healthcare camps across rural communities, focusing on populations with little or no access to medical services. A total of 38 camps were held in five districts, where dedicated doctors and healthcare staff provided a wide range of essential services. These included general health checkups for families, specialized screenings for chronic illnesses such as diabetes and hypertension, maternal and child health consultations, distribution of essential medicines, and awareness sessions on preventive offered healthcare. also The camps on nutrition, sanitation, and counseling women's issues—empowering health individuals to take proactive steps toward better well-being. For patients requiring further care, timely referrals were made to specialized medical facilities, ensuring they received the treatment they needed without delay.

Why we did

In Bangladesh, healthcare remains deeply unequal. While nearly 70% of the population lives in rural areas, most hospitals and facilities are concentrated in cities, leaving millions without access to doctors or affordable medicine. Women face the greatest barriers, enduring untreated health issues and lifethreatening complications in silence. To bridge this gap, P4H organizes free medical camps—bringing doctors, medicines, and health education directly to the communities most in need.




